2022 dog licenses are available at the Treasurer's Office. To obtain a license, proof of a current rabies vaccination certificate is needed. The Township sells only the 1-year license. 3-year licenses are available at Oakland County Animal Control. Please call Animal Control at (248) 858-1090 for more information. The license fees are \$15.00 if the dog is spayed or neutered and \$25.00 if the dog is not spayed or neutered. If the pet owner is a senior citizen (65 years or older) the license fees are \$14.00 if the dog is spayed or neutered and \$23.00 if the dog is not spayed or neutered.
