



## Waterford Township Residents – 2023 Waste/ Recycling/ Compost Information

**WATERFORD RESIDENTS RECEIVE TRASH AND COMPOST SERVICES EVERY WEEK. COMPOST WILL BE PICKED UP WEEKLY STARTING APRIL 3 TO DECEMBER 15, 2023.** Weekly subscription recycling service is available, if selected. If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled day, pickup will be one day later than normal. If a holiday falls on a weekend, your scheduled pickup day will **NOT** change. **Observed holidays are: New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.**

**Annual payments must be paid in full by 4/1/23 to receive discount.** For billing assistance call **248.204.6762** or to enroll in Autopay go to [myaccount.gflenv.com](http://myaccount.gflenv.com). VISA, American Express, Discover and Mastercard are accepted. Accounts that are not paid within 45 days of the date of invoice or by the 30th day of the service period will be assessed a 10% late fee. Unpaid invoices and late fee amounts after August 15 each year may be assigned to the property tax roll with an additional 6% administrative fee for collections on the December tax bill.

**ALL MATERIALS SHOULD BE SET AT THE CURB BY 7:00 am** on your scheduled pickup day. Containers should not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds each. For those with special pickup needs, contact **GFL Environmental at 248.204.6762**.

**UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS** include tires, concrete, fencing, any contractor generated materials, free liquids (paints, pesticides, etc.), car parts, appliances containing Freon, fluorescent bulbs, human or uncontained excrement, animal bodies and car batteries.

**BULK ITEMS:** Collection of one large bulk item per month such as appliances and furniture will be available on your regular collection day. Please set your bulk items at the curbside separate from other waste and recycling by **7:00 am** on your collection day. You do not need to call to request special pickup of those items.

**SNOWBIRD SERVICE SUSPENSION:** If you'll be away from your Waterford home for an extended period, please notify GFL by calling **248.204.6762** or emailing [gflcustomerservice@gflenv.com](mailto:gflcustomerservice@gflenv.com) to suspend service and payment for a single period of up to three (3) consecutive months in any 12 month period. The maximum suspension in any calendar year is three (3) months.

**COMPOST/YARD WASTE:** In season April 3 – December 15, 2023, unlimited yard waste will be collected weekly. Place yard waste in brown yard waste bags or in plastic 32-gallon containers clearly marked "X" facing the street. Branches are to be no more than two inches in diameter, no longer than four feet in length, and must be bundled. Bundles and containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. No tree stumps or trunks are accepted. No compost will be accepted in plastic bags.

<b>Newspaper</b>	Place newspapers, phone books, magazines and glossy newspaper inserts in brown paper bags or bundle and tie with string.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Clean, corrugated cardboard must be broken down, bundled and tied in two (2) foot squares, not exceeding a thickness of one (1) foot.
<b>Plastic #1-7</b>	Plastics should be rinsed clean with the cap removed. No motor oil, anti-freeze or cooking oil containers please.
<b>Cans</b>	Clean tin and aluminum cans. These items may be flattened to conserve space in your container.
<b>Glass</b>	Clear, brown and green empty glass. The glass should be rinsed out.
