WORK SESSION MINUTES

1. Single Trash Hauler Ordinance was reviewed prior to sending to Township Attorney.
2. Lot Line Adjustment for SD Capital was discussed. Back taxes are due and that is a condition of lot line adjustments so consensus was to deny request. SD Capital will be advised.
3. Owner of the lot adjacent to Andersonville Church is in the process of buying the building that houses World of Glass. He would like to combine that property with the vacant lot to provide parking for the building. He is proposing a mixed use of some kind for the property.
4. Tim Patterson, business owner on Walton Blvd., produced a petition signed by 788 residents/business owners on Walton to fix the pavement on Walton. Walton is scheduled for repair/replacement by OCRC in 2021. A temporary fix for the first section would cost the Township \$150,000 (1/3 of the cost) and this repair would be torn out in 2021 for the repair/ replacement scheduled by RCOC. The second portion of Walton would cost Waterford \$250,000 (1/3 of the cost) and OCRC does not have this section of the road on their calendar for any work. After discussion the board consensus is there is no funding for these projects.
5. Quiet Zones at railroad crossings were discussed. The expense to produce these quiet zones would fall to the Township and cost approximately \$250,000 per railroad crossing. We have 7 railroad crossings in Waterford. Board consensus is that we have no funding for this project.
