1. Hatchery Rd surplus property: Consensus is to renew listing and reduce listing price to \$295,000.
2. Walton Blvd. road repairs: previously board consensus was 4-3 against spending money on temporary repairs. RCOC is now doing \$150,000 in repair work this year and full repair is scheduled for 2021. No change in consensus,
3. Single Trash Hauler: Attorney is working on ordinance and was just given the task of preparing the bid packet. Scheduled for Introduction at the September 10, 2018 board meeting.
4. Thomas asked about number of code enforcement officers (1 full time, 2 part time) because he has noticed several code violations.
5. Community Center renderings will be ready for the September 13 Town Hall meeting
6. Susan Coxen asked for closed caption/hearing assist at Board Meetings
7. Rhonda Marshall has reached out to see what is being done to revise massage parlor ordinance. Police Chief has asked we not change it much because it gives the PD authority to shut down illicit operations.
8. Board is in a "wait and see" posture on marijuana. After the November election and recreational marijuana is settled we will see how the laws change.
9. Elections went smoothly in Waterford in August
