

From the Director

Following a slow start this year, the library was able to make strides restarting services impacted by the pandemic. Programs for all ages included a combination of in-person events, Zoom presentations and Make & Take Craft kits, which have been very popular.

Service improvements included new Express Checkout stations, additional mobile hotspots for loan, enhanced chat service for Reference questions, and new 3D barcode scanners to expedite checkout of materials. The Friends of the Library sponsored purchase of upgraded AWE Early Learning workstations for the Children's Room and new laptops for our laptop lab, used in hands-on computer instruction classes.

Library staff participated in several community events including the annual Chamber Business Expo, Movie Palooza, Waterford Senior Center Health Fair and Holiday Hoopla.


Volunteer support:

- ◆ Family Library Nights initiated by PTO and staff at Waterford's elementary schools offering students and their families an introduction to the library and a chance to get their first library cards.



- ◆ Restoration of the Outreach mini-branch at Whispering Woods


LIBRARY VISITS 3-YEAR COMPARISON
