2. **Announcements**
 - 2.1. Beginning March 1, 2024, delinquent 2023 Summer and Winter property taxes can no longer be paid at the Waterford Township Treasurer's Office. They now must be paid at the Oakland County Treasurer's Office, which is located at 1200 N. Telegraph Road, Pontiac. For more information, please contact the Oakland County Treasurer's Office at 248-858-0611.
 - 2.2. Township Offices will be closed on Friday, March 29, 2024, and the Library will be closed on Saturday, March 30, 2024, and Sunday, March 31, 2024, for Easter. All emergency services will be available.
 - 2.3. It's almost that time again! Spring cleanup is right around the corner. For Waterford GFL curbside collection customers, unlimited yard waste will be collected weekly from April 1 - December 13, 2024. Place yard waste in brown yard waste bags or plastic 32-gallon containers clearly marked as yard waste facing the street. For permanent containers, stop by Town Hall or the Department of Public Works for COMPOST stickers; brown yard waste bags don't need to be marked. Compost in plastic bags will not be accepted for compost pick-up. Branches no more than two inches in diameter, no longer than four feet in length, and bundled in batches are accepted curbside. Bundles and containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. For a full list of yard waste details, please visit the Waterford Township website at www.waterfordmi.gov/trash. Questions?  - 2.4. Starting April 1, 2024, residents, businesses, and visitors will begin to see trucks from Wachs Water Services (photo below) throughout the Township completing the DPW Valve Assessment and Exercising Program. The Wachs Water Services crews will be assessing and exercising approximately 3,800 valves in the water distribution system. If required, crews will complete minor repairs on a number of the valves. The valves are located in green belts, easements, and along roadways, usually in wells with manhole covers. The crews may have to close traffic lanes for short periods of time for their safety and the safety of motorists. Patience and understanding would be appreciated. The project is expected to take four to five months. It will start in Section 1 of the Township and continue through each section sequentially. If you have questions or concerns, contact the DPW at (248) 674-2278.
 - 2.5. Volunteers are needed for the 9th annual Earth Day Township cleanup event on Saturday, April 20th. Join volunteers as we hit the streets and parks in our community to help clean up litter from roadsides and common areas. Last year, nearly 140 volunteers collected over one TON of trash in 30 locations across the Township. Be part of a great event that makes an immediate and positive impact on the community!
 - 2.6. Waterford Township has partnered with the North Oakland Household Hazardous Waste Consortium (NO HAZ), which provides participating community residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). The first event will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Oakland County Service Center Campus, 1200 N. Telegraph Road, Pontiac. Please follow the signs on campus. Registration links will be posted on the No Haz website www.nohaz.org approximately three weeks before each collection date. You must register in advance. Waterford Residents pay a fee of \$15. *Please note that in-person sales at the Development Services office or on the day of the event will NOT take place this year. Online registration only.

 - 2.8. One-year 2024 dog licenses are still available at the Waterford Township Treasurer's Office, located at 5200 Civic Center Drive, Waterford. To obtain a license, proof of a current rabies vaccination certificate is needed. The license fees are: \$15.00 if the dog is spayed or neutered, \$25.00 if the dog is not spayed or neutered. If the pet owner is a senior citizen (65 years or older): \$14.00 if the dog is spayed or neutered. \$23.00 if the dog is not spayed or neutered. 3-year dog licenses are available at Oakland County Animal Control. Please call Animal Control at (248) 858-1090 for more information. Their shelter is located at 1200 N. Telegraph Road, Building 42 East, in Pontiac, next to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office headquarters.
