 - 5.1. The Waterford Parks and Recreation Department's registration counter inside Township Hall will be CLOSED permanently beginning 3/17/2025. As always, our online registration system will be operational and accept phone-in registrations and reservations. Our main phone line is 248-674-5441.  - 5.2. It's almost that time again! Spring cleanup is right around the corner. For Waterford Priority Waste curbside collection customers, unlimited yard waste will be collected weekly from April 1 through December 12, 2025. Yard waste must be at the curb by 7 a.m. on your regular weekly collection day -- Priority Waste will not return for late sets. Reminder: Place yard waste in brown yard waste bags or plastic 32-gallon containers marked "Yard Waste" facing the street. Branches must be no more than two inches in diameter and no longer than four feet long and must be bundled. Bundles and containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. No tree stumps or trunks are accepted. No compost will be accepted in plastic bags.
 - 5.3. Township Offices will be closed on Friday, April 18, 2025, in observance of Good Friday. All emergency services will be available.
 - 5.4. Waterford Township Public Library Easter Weekend Hours. The Library will be conducting morning all-staff training for staff. Therefore, the Library will be closed on Thursday, April 17 in the morning and will be open from 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. That will be a good opportunity to stock up on library materials because Easter Weekend immediately follows. The library will be closed Friday, April 18 through Sunday, April 20. Regular library hours resume on Monday, April 21.
 - 5.5. Volunteers are needed for the 10th annual Earth Day Township cleanup event on Saturday, April 26th. Join volunteers as we hit the streets and parks in our community to help clean up litter from roadsides and common areas. Last year, nearly 140 volunteers collected over one TON of trash in 30 locations across the Township. Be part of a great event that immediately and positively impacts on the community! This is an excellent volunteer opportunity for groups and individuals looking to make a difference in the Waterford community!
 - 5.6. Earth Day Shredding will occur on Saturday, April 26, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Waterford Township Civic Center Campus, 5200 Civic Center Drive. Limit three (3) boxes per household.
 - 5.7. The time has come to start planning for this year's Memorial Day Parade! This year's parade will occur on Monday, May 26, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. We will follow the same parade route as last year, straight up Dixie Highway, starting at Sashabaw Road and ending at Williams Lake Road. All the other details are being finalized. If your group wishes to participate, please take a moment to fill out an application. We use the information we are requesting to set our line-up and provide Media10 with information to talk about your group on the parade broadcast. I am attaching this year's flyer. Waterford Township has partnered with the North Oakland Household Hazardous Waste Consortium (NO HAZ), which provides participating community residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). The first event will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Oakland County Service Center Campus, 1200 N. Telegraph Road, Pontiac. Please follow the signs on campus. Registration links will be posted on the No Haz website www.nohaz.org approximately three weeks before each collection date. You must register in advance. Waterford Residents pay a fee of \$15. **Online registration only. **Please note that in-person sales at the Development Services office or on the day of the event will NOT take place this year.**


