What is a space rental?

A space rental is \$20.00 for Waterford residents, \$25.00 for non-residents. One space per household. Each space is approximately 10' x 10'. Renters must keep all of their items within their assigned space; items cannot protrude into walkways where they could cause someone to trip or fall. Renters are responsible for pricing and tagging their own items, and arranging them in an attractive and orderly manner. Renters are required to provide their own change and their own bags. Waterford Parks and Recreation Department will not provide these items. Renters are expected to act as their own security for items they bring to sell. Waterford Parks and Recreation Department is not responsible for items or money that are stolen from renters.

How do I register and what is the registration deadline?

Registration can be done in-person, over the phone or online. Registration deadline is Friday, April 14, 2023 at 5:00pm.

Are retail sales or crafters/vendors allowed?

No

What if I need a refund?

No refunds will be issued.

Can I bring my own table?

No. The Waterford Parks and Recreation Department provides one 8' table.

What do I do with clothing racks or large items?

All racks and large items must be contained within your 10'x10' space.

When can I set up?

Friday, April 21, 2023, from 4:30pm-7:30pm or Saturday, April 22, 2023, between 6:30am-7:30am. Renters must be set-up and ready to sell when we open doors to shoppers at 8:00am. Renters are responsible for bringing in and setting up all of their items. There will not be staff at the facility to assist in setting up or carrying in items.

Can I pick my location in the gym/dining room?

No. Waterford Parks and Recreation will be doing the table assigning.

When will I find out my location in the room?

Monday, April 17, 2023, the coordinator will email all renters with a map of layout of the building and a list of where their space will be. Spaces will be in the gymnasium and the dining room; double doors join these areas together so shoppers can travel easily between both areas.

When does the sale start and end?

Early Bird Shoppers will start arriving at 8:00am for an admission charge of \$3.00. General admission is 9:00am-1:00pm for \$2.00. Sale ends at 1:00 PM. Renters are expected to stay until 1:00pm. Renters cannot begin packing up their items to leave until 1:00pm.

How will I know if there are any spaces left?

We will be selling a maximum of 45 spaces. This maximum limit is set in our registration system and can viewed online.

Can renters bring their own children to the event?

If a renter brings their children to the sale, they are responsible for their own child-care and for keeping them supervised.
