HELPFUL TIPS

Helpful tips to keep in mind when decorating your loved ones marker.


Plant deer and/or rabbit resistant plants.

If you can't maintain it, please do not plant it.

Use a leveled garden tile within the flower area, to place statues, urns or pots. This keeps them from tipping and keeps grass from growing too close to the base.

Do not leave anything of value (either financial or sentimental) at the graves. The cemetery is open at all hours and we do not have lights or security cameras.

If you do want a flowerbed, installing a border helps to keep the mowers from the flowers and makes your bed look neat and well kept.



All plantings and/or decorations must be:

- On the grave only.
- 12 inches from front of marker & 4 inches on either side.
- Nothing behind the marker; including shepherd's hooks.
- No decorations on foot markers.

Please Remember-

- **No** plantings with thorns; including rose bushes.
- **No** trees, bushes or shrubs.
- **No** decorative stones or mulch.
- **No** glass of any type. Only plastic, cement, or resin is allowed.
- **No** alcoholic beverages.
- **No** artificial plants, flowers or decorations allowed between April 1st through October 15th.
