	6 soccer fields in varying sizes	
<b>2</b>	<b>Warming House, 5050 Civic Center Dr.</b>	<b>0.5 acres</b>
	Indoor/outdoor rental facility with kitchenette with views of the Civic Center Pond	
<b>3</b>	<b>Drayton Plains Nature Center, 2125 Denby Dr.</b>	<b>13.8 acres</b>
	Interpretive building open seasonally, pavilion, grills, ponds and scenic trails for wildlife viewing	
<b>4</b>	<b>Hess-Hathaway Park, 825 S. Williams Lk. Rd.</b>	<b>16.7 acres</b>
	NO PETS ALLOWED, only service animals are recognized by the ADA. Historic farmhouse & barn, animal exhibit farm, playground, 2 pavilions, gazebo, community building, restrooms, ball field, 2 sand volleyball courts, 3 horseshoe pits, community garden and scenic trails	
<b>5</b>	<b>Clinton River Canoe Site, 5971 Elizabeth Lk. Rd</b>	<b>8 acres</b>
	Covered bridge, pavilion, grill, kayak storage rack and seating along the river	
<b>6</b>	<b>Elizabeth Lake Woods Park</b>	<b>34.0 acres</b>
	Access off Locahven Rd. (parking area) & River Ridge Dr. Scenic natural area along Clinton River	
<b>7</b>	<b>Fish Hatchery Park, 4490 Hatchery Rd.</b>	<b>6.3 acres</b>
	Home to Waterford Historical Society, 3 pavilions and restrooms	
<b>8</b>	<b>Herrington Park, 1216 Lochaven Rd.</b>	<b>35 acres</b>
	2 lighted ball fields, pavilion, grill, concession stand and restrooms	
<b>9</b>	<b>Lions Park, 4250 Fenmore Ave.</b>	<b>26.5 acres</b>
	Regulation sized baseball field, pavilion, grill, concession stand and restrooms	
<b>10</b>	<b>Maceday Lake Park, Off Rich Dr.</b>	<b>7 acres</b>
	Located on Maceday Lake, this protected bird sanctuary has rustic trails and very limited parking	
<b>11</b>	<b>Marion Street Park, at end of Marian Ave.</b>	<b>18 acres</b>
	Marian Ave. is off Elizabeth Lk. Rd. Paved walking trail with scenic views	
<b>12</b>	<b>Optimist Park, 5320 Elizabeth Lk. Rd.</b>	<b>10 acres</b>
	Second entrance off Clinton River Dr., 3 ball fields, pavilion, half-court basketball, and playground	
<b>13</b>	<b>Rotary Park, 5485 Tubbs Rd.</b>	<b>12 acres</b>
	2 ball fields, pavilion, grill, restrooms, concession stand and playground	
<b>14</b>	<b>Shell Park, 4373 Dixie Hwy.</b>	<b>13 acres</b>
	Second entrance off Frembes Rd., 3 ball fields (one lighted field), pavilion, grill and restrooms	
<b>15</b>	<b>Clinton River South, 5250 Cass Elizabeth Rd.</b>	<b>36 acres</b>
	Natural wetland area surrounding Haviland Elementary along both sides of the Clinton River	
<b>16</b>	<b>Leggett Campus, 3621 Pontiac Lk Rd.</b>	<b>9 acres</b>
	Formerly referred to as the Waterford Senior Center, home to senior programs and services such as Meals on Wheels, congregate lunch, Encore Adult Day Program and more.
