For multi-team meets (three or more teams), renter is required to provide port-a-johns at the park for use during their meet.

Rental Availability (April 15-October 15)

Rental requests may be made for dates that fall after October 15, and will be reviewed and approved on a case-by-case basis, taking into account Hess-Hathaway Park's reduced hours after October 15. Any rentals approved for after October 15 will incur an additional \$30.00/hour fee in addition to the rental fees listed above. No rentals available Wednesdays and Thursdays October 16-April 14, the park is closed.

Course Modifications Prohibited

Renters are not allowed to make changes or modifications to existing cross-country trails/courses. Renters cannot move signage or flagging that is already placed on the cross-country trails/courses.

Concession Sales

Renters wishing to sell concessions or utilize an outside concessionaire must make arrangements with the Waterford Parks and Recreation Department upon making field reservations.

Insurance Needs

All renters must provide a Certificate of Insurance naming Waterford Township as an additional insured on a primary and non-contributory basis 30-days prior to date of rental. Limit of liability shall not be less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$3,000,000 comprehensive: for personal injury, bodily injury and property damage.

Pets

Renters are responsible for communicating to their spectators that no dogs or pets are allowed at Hess-Hathaway Park. Only service animals that are trained to do work or perform a task for persons with disabilities are allowed. Comfort and/or emotional support animals are not service animals, and are not recognized by the ADA. Dogs and pets that are not service animals will be required to leave the park.
