PARENT'S INFORMATION

SEASON: A six-game season will be played on Sundays starting on or after 11:00AM. If there are an odd number of teams in any age group, double-header games may be played during the season. **12U-14/16U Age Groups:** May have both weekday and weekend games in surrounding communities.

COACHES NEEDED: Coaches and assistants are necessary to run this program. We depend upon parents to fill these positions. Clinics and/or handouts are available to instruct coaches. **This program is based on volunteer coaching. Once teams are formed, if no parent from your child's team volunteers to coach, your money will be refunded and the team will be disbanded. No coaching experience is necessary.**

Players will play in the age group according to their birth year. No one will be allowed to move down in any age group. A player may move up one year if a player up-waiver is signed by a parent. Teams will be assigned by previous season's rosters, then by school, and then by the coordinators discretion.

EQUIPMENT: Players must provide a practice ball and shin guards.

Background Checks

Each **head coach and assistant coach** is required to submit a background check every year now. VOLUNTEER COACHES AGREEMENT FOR YOUTH SPORTS

All coaches affiliated with Waterford Township Parks and Recreation Department programs must be familiar with and adhere to the rules, regulations and philosophy established in each individual sports manager manual.

As a volunteer coach, **I AGREE TO:**

- Treat each player, opposing coach, official, parent and league administrator with respect and dignity.
- Do my best to learn the fundamental skills, teaching and evaluation techniques, and strategies of my sport.
- Become thoroughly familiar with the rules of my sport.
- Become familiar with the objectives of the youth sports program with which I coach, and I will assist them in every way to conduct fair and impartial competitive contests.
- Uphold the authority of officials who are assigned to the contests in which I coach, and I will assist them in every way to conduct fair and impartial competitive contests.
- Learn the strengths and weaknesses of my players so that I might place them into situations where they have a maximum opportunity to achieve success.
- Conduct my practices and games so that all players have an opportunity to safely improve their skill level through active participation.
- Communicate to my players and their parents the right and responsibilities of individuals on my team.
- Cooperate with the administrators of our organization in the enforcement of rules, regulations and program philosophy, and I will report any irregularities that violated sound competitive or ethical practices or situations which may be deemed questionable or not in the best interest of the participants.
- Protect the health and safety of my players by insisting that all of the activities under my control are conducted for their psychological and physiological welfare, rather than for the vicarious interests of adults. I will report all injuries to parents and administrators as required.
- Have two adults present at all practice sessions.
- To complete all forms required.
- Return all equipment provided at the end of the season and report any defective equipment immediately.
