

FARM ATTENDANT (18yrs. +)

Responsibilities include: feeding/caring for farm animals, supervising park activities, events, & rentals, assisting with field trips & birthday parties, and opening/closing the park. Must have a valid operator's license.

NATURE CENTER ATTENDANT (18yrs. +)

Do you love nature and sharing it with others? Come work at the Drayton Plains Nature Center! Must have experience with and a passion for Michigan's wildlife, ecosystems, natural features, and engaging with the community. Responsibilities include: opening, closing, and cleaning the building, welcoming patrons; developing creative and interactive displays; and leading programs for visitors to participate in.

PARKS MAINTENANCE WORKER (18yrs. +)

Responsibilities include: lining ball fields, restroom cleanup, trash pickup/removal, prepping soccer fields, general landscaping, maintenance, and painting. Must have a valid operator's license.

ATHLETIC FIELD ATTENDANT (18yrs. +)

Starting at \$16.64/hour

Working at various athletic fields, overseeing games/events/rentals. Liaison between the department and coaches, parents, spectators, and officials. Must possess great customer service skills and the ability to resolve conflicts.

Schedule will vary based on when fields and facilities are in use.
