# Teen Summer Reading Program

June 17<sup>th</sup> – August 3<sup>rd</sup>

For 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders

Register for our Summer Reading Program starting June 17<sup>th</sup>. We've made it simpler this year. You just have to log the number of minutes you read over a 7-week period. Ideally, your goal should be to read at least 20 minutes a day. We know summer is busy with all kinds of activities, but it's important to keep reading over the summer in order to stay sharp for when school starts up again. You can read books, graphic novels, magazines, newspapers, and comic books. e-Content and audiobooks are acceptable as well.

Prizes will be awarded when you complete the following:

**200 minutes – Pick something from the teen prize box**

**350 minutes – Pick something from the teen prize box**

**700 minutes or more – Pick out a new book**

**Deadline to log your minutes is August 3<sup>rd</sup> at midnight.**

**The last day to pick up your prizes is Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>.**

A final raffle drawing will be held for participants who logged at least 100 minutes. Participants will have one chance to win for every 100 minutes they've logged.
