Number 7 on the license application checklist requires "Written consents or approvals of proposed facility by *adjacent* owners and occupants." Can you please more specifically define "adjacent"? Section 10.301(b)(8) of the ordinance uses the word "*adjoining*".

The Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines "adjoining" as "touching or or bounding at a point or line."

The Merriam-Webster Dictionary defines "adjacent" as 1. "nearby" or 2. "having a common endpoint or border".

As stated in its first paragraph, the Information/Document Checklist attached to the Medical Marihuana Facility License Application that was approved as Exhibit B of the Township Board's November 23, 2020, Resolution Approving Medical Marihuana Facility License Procedures, Forms, and Fees, is only a summary of information and documents described in subsections (1) – (25) of Ordinance Section 10-301(b) that are also attached to the Application.

The "adjoining" language of Section 10-301(b)(8) is controlling and the Township confirms that it will be interpreted as "touching or bounding at a point or line."
