TOWNSHIP CORRECTED RESPONSE

Under the REGULATIONS FOR MEDICAL MARIHUANA USES, that are being added to the Zoning Ordinance as a new Section 2-604 effective January 4, 2021, a single medical marihuana primary caregiver's accessory use of a dwelling as an accessory use home occupation shall be reviewed under the Change of Use site plan review process in Section 4-004.1 of the Zoning Ordinance.

For up to six (6) medical marihuana primary caregivers to engage in the medical use of marihuana on a zoning lot in the M-1, Light Industrial, M-2, General Industrial, or Summit Place Overlay Districts after wellhead protection compliance requires major site plan review based on the criteria in Section 4-004.3 of the Zoning Ordinance.

Those medical marihuana primary caregiver uses do not require a Township License under the Medical Marihuana Facility Licensing Ordinance.
