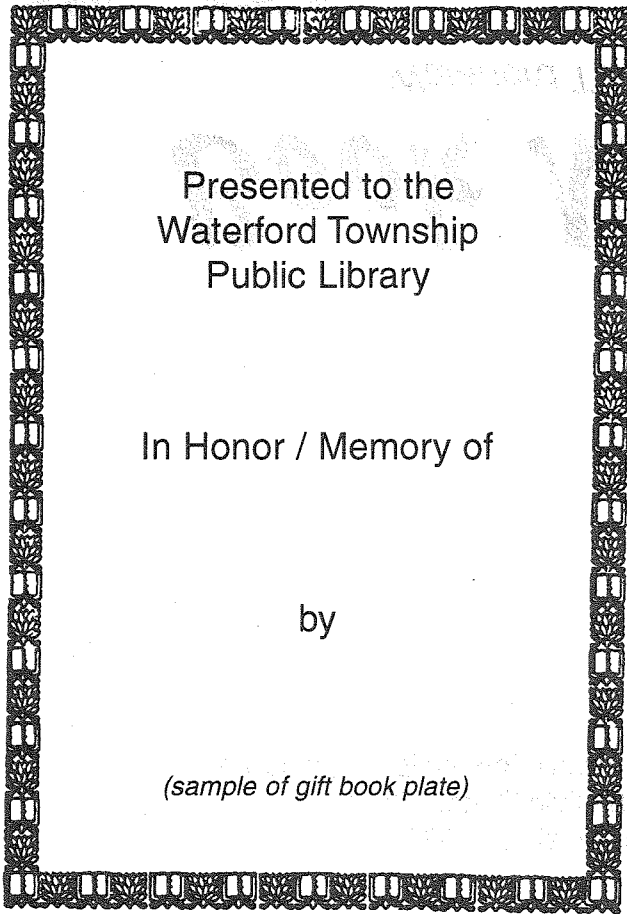

If you do not wish to designate a specific subject, you can make your contribution in general for the purchase of books.

A book gift to the library need not be necessarily an "in memoriam." It can be - and has been - given to commemorate an occasion, a birthday, anniversary, or other milestones.

Acknowledgement goes to the donor and to the person, or the family of the person being honored, and a bookplate is placed in the gift book.
