

# My Library Hotspot


Getting started: **Franklin T9**

## Buttons and icons

There's a lot you can do with this library hotspot, so here's a quick glance of some basic items to get you started.

### Buttons

1. **Power/Menu Button** – Turn on/off T9. Shows device menu and information

Button Operation	Operations	Actions
	Turn On	Press and hold the button for 3 seconds.
	Turn Off	Press and hold the button until "Goodbye" message appears.
	Display Wake-Up	When the display is off (sleep mode), the first quick press of the button wakes up the display.
	Info Display	When the display is on, press the button quickly to go through the device menu and information.

### First time use



When you first turn on the device, you might see a setup wizard to help get you started.

Look at the steps below to walk through the setup process. You can use the T9 as a wireless mobile hotspot to connect to a total of 8 Wi-Fi capable devices to the mobile broadband network for unlimited data use.

### Wi-Fi Name (SSID) and Password:

You can find the Wi-Fi Name and Password any time you need it. Just press the power/menu button shortly when the display is on.

 Press  quickly      Password display

1. Power on the hotspot

Press  quickly

2. Open the Wi-Fi application or controls on your laptop or phone or another Wi-Fi capable device that you want to connect to the hotspot. Then find the T9 hotspot's Wi-Fi name in your settings.
3. Click **Connect** and enter the Password when prompted.
4. Open your browser on your device and you are good to go!
