Teen Summer Reading Program

Teen Summer Reading Program

June 1st – July 31st

For 6th – 12th graders

Register for our Summer Reading Program starting June 1st. Log the number of minutes you read over a 9-week period. Ideally, your goal should be to read at least 20 minutes a day. We know summer is busy with all kinds of activities, but it's important to keep reading over the summer in order to stay sharp for when school starts up again. You can read books, graphic novels, magazines, newspapers, and comic books. e-Content and audiobooks are acceptable as well.

Deadline to log your minutes is July 31st at 5 pm.

In early August, three prizes will be awarded to randomly drawn participants who have logged at least **500** minutes.

2nd prize – Bluetooth Speaker/Night Light

3rd prize – \$25.00 Meijer gift card
