



Waterford Township Public Library Children's Services 2021 Fall Programs

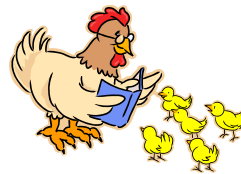

Bring a blanket and maybe something extra for damp grass, or chairs to sit on, and dress for the weather. When rain or cold weather sets in, storytime will be held in the community room. Storytimes are about 30 minutes long. Children must be accompanied by a parent or a caregiver.
